\$13	\$35	\$50

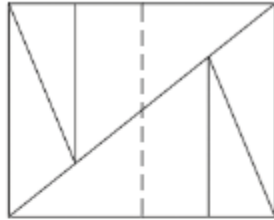
Krielle will need a ticket for the following days of the month: 2, 3, 4, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, and 21.

How much is the cheapest valid combination Krielle could use?

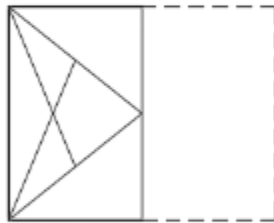

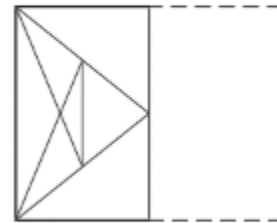
Find out from amongst the four alternatives as to how the pattern would appear when the transparent sheet is folded at the dotted line.



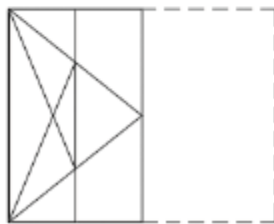

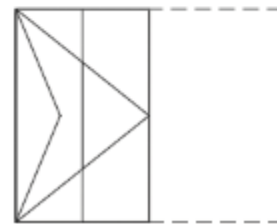
