
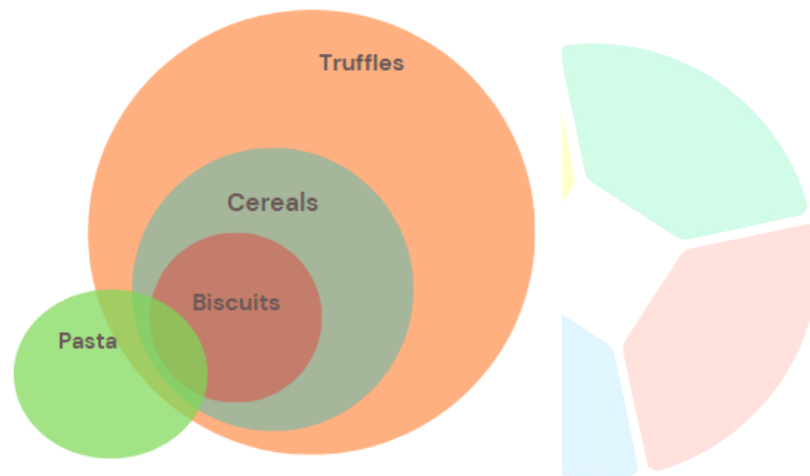

3	<p>Johnson tried to respond to Anna's claim by attacking her status as an engineer. It does not logically refute Anna's claim regarding her ability to teach kids how to sing. Johnson commits an Ad Hominem fallacy. Option C is the correct answer.</p>
4	<p>It can be properly concluded that a doctor's prescription is important and should be followed because eye drops can cure a lot of eye disorders. The statements in the other options are all incorrect because they offer little relevance to the topic being discussed. Option C is the correct answer.</p>

We can figure this out by dividing the total amount of money he earned by the selling price of one milkshake.</p> <p>$\\$348 / \\$12 = 29$</p> <p>Since each milkshake requires about 3 cups of milk, we have to multiply the total number of milkshakes sold by 3.</p> <p>$29 \times 3 = 87$ cups of milk were used in total.</p> <p>Option C is the correct answer.</p>

Even though there is no logical proof to support the claim, Harvey's father still believes that not eating breakfast would lead to a chain of future events like not being able to answer exam questions, not obtaining a diploma to get a job and other things which could lead to a bad outcome of becoming poor.</p> <p>Option C is the correct answer.</p>
13	<p>Go backward from the third position. Open the fold and mirror the hole with respect to the dotted line. Fold the paper consecutively.</p> <p>Every time you open the fold, mirror the punch.</p>  <p>Option A is the correct answer.</p>
14	<p>The main argument claims that offering higher wages and training will solve the shortage of health care workers in Australia. The best statement that strengthens it is Option A since it explains the incentive of employees on picking what kind of job they will apply for. Although Option D does not clash with the argument, it offers minimal relevance in strengthening it since it only proves how wages impact the extravagant lifestyle of medical professionals.</p> <p>Thus, A is the correct answer.</p>

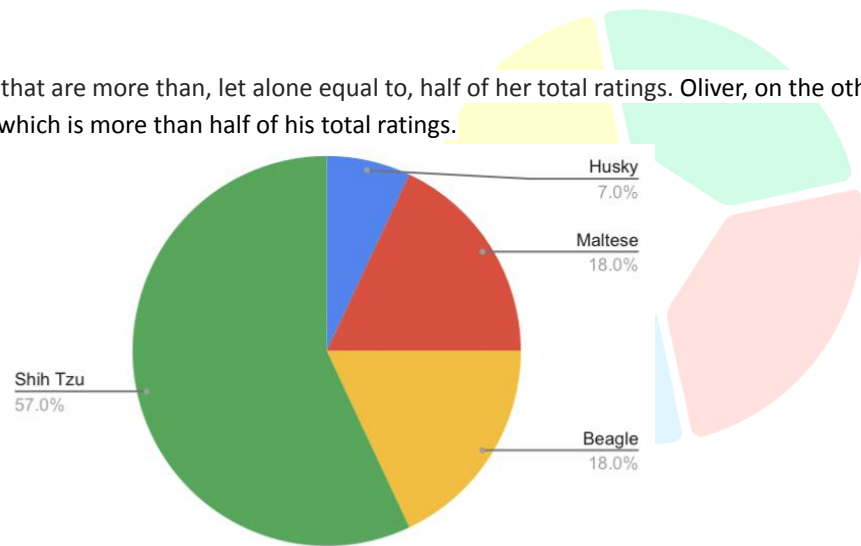

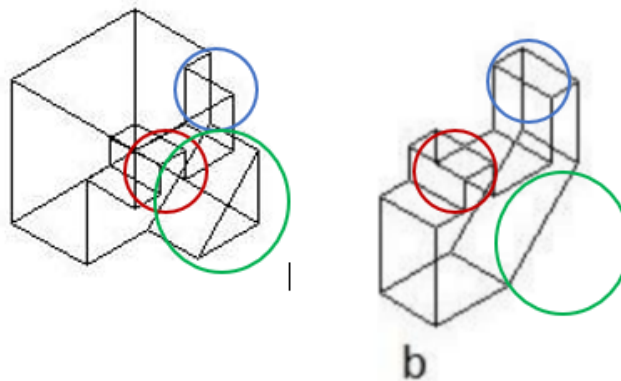

Therefore, B is the correct answer.

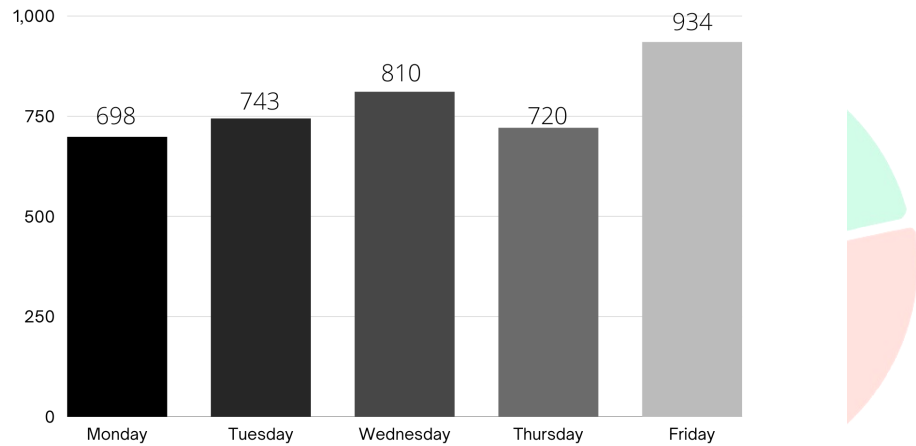
