#1: (First paragraph) a. Strengths:

The statement "poverty was increasing and decreasing at the same time" is contradictory and confusing. The resolution feels rushed and doesn't fully address the consequences of Wulfric's actions.

c. Exemplar: "In the years that followed, Wulfric worked tirelessly to make amends. Though some still blamed him for the economic crisis, many recognized his efforts to right his wrongs. Now a young man, Wulfric had grown into a diligent scholar, focusing on helping his community recover from the lingering effects of his childhood mistake."
