#1 (First paragraph): a. Strengths:

- Intriguing opening that sets the scene and introduces characters
- Creative concept of a space cruise
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Lack of detail and context Your opening paragraph leaves the reader with many questions. Who are these cousins? Why are they on a space cruise? What is the significance of the X-roid? Providing more context would help engage the reader from the start.
- c. Exemplar: "The four cousins, each with their unique personalities, found themselves aboard the X-roid, a state-of-the-art spaceship doubling as a luxury cruise liner. It was their annual family holiday, but this year promised to be unlike any other."

#2 (Sixth paragraph): a. Strengths:

- Reveals an interesting plot twist about the adults' secret organisation
- Introduces conflict and raises stakes
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Rushed exposition You introduce a significant amount of information in a single paragraph without allowing the reader to process it. The revelation about the secret organisation and the alien invasion feels abrupt and lacks proper build-up.
- c. Exemplar: "As Maisie delved deeper into her aunt's tablet, her eyes widened with each discovery. The annual holiday wasn't just a family tradition; it was a cover for something far more significant. Their parents and aunts and uncles were part of a secret organisation, tasked with protecting Earth from alien threats."

#3 (Eighth and ninth paragraphs): a. Strengths:

- Introduces conflict and resolution
- Attempts to provide a moral lesson
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Underdeveloped resolution The conflict resolution feels rushed and lacks depth. The transition from potential violence to understanding happens too quickly, and the moral lesson at the end feels forced rather than naturally developed through the story.
- c. Exemplar: "As tensions escalated, Maisie's voice cut through the chaos. 'Wait!' she shouted, her eyes locked on the smallest alien. 'Let's hear them out.' In the tense

silence that followed, the cousins learned a valuable lesson about assumptions and the importance of communication."

Actionable task: Rewrite the sixth paragraph, focusing on pacing the reveal of information about the secret organisation and alien invasion. Break it into smaller chunks and weave it throughout the story to create a more engaging narrative arc.
