## #1 (First paragraph): a. Strengths:

- You've created an intriguing opening that sets the scene and introduces the main characters.
- The mention of the war and its impact on the characters adds depth to the narrative.
- b. Weaknesses: Lack of Clarity and Cohesion Your opening paragraph contains several inconsistencies and unclear elements. For instance, you mention "four cousins" but only name three. The sentence "We were starting to board the ship as we stop quite a queer site" is confusing and grammatically incorrect. Additionally, the transition from boarding the ship to being in the sauna is abrupt and lacks detail.
- c. Exemplar: "As my cousins Ruth, Callum, Joseph, and I boarded the majestic Stargazer, we witnessed a peculiar sight: a figure that resembled a zombie. Despite its familiarity, we chose to ignore it, focusing instead on our much-needed holiday after the war that had claimed our fathers' lives."

## #2 (Second paragraph): a. Strengths:

- The vivid description of the nightmare creates tension and foreshadows potential events.
- The use of first-person narration effectively conveys the protagonist's emotions.
- b. Weaknesses: Inconsistent Tone and Pacing Your writing shifts abruptly from a horrifying nightmare to a calm stargazing scene without adequate transition. The phrase "It had been quite a strange nightmare" understates the intense fear previously described. The final rhetorical question feels out of place and doesn't effectively tie the paragraph together.
- c. Exemplar: "I awoke in a pool of sweat, the nightmare's vivid imagery still fresh in my mind. Though I tried to dismiss it as a mere dream, an uneasy feeling lingered. Seeking solace, I stepped outside and set down a mat to stargaze, hoping the night sky would calm my troubled thoughts."

## #3 (Third paragraph): a. Strengths:

- The action sequence of falling through the floor creates excitement and moves the plot forward.
- The introduction of zombies adds a supernatural element to the story.

b. Weaknesses: Rushed Plot Development and Logical Inconsistencies Your third paragraph introduces several major plot points in quick succession without adequate development. The sudden appearance of zombies and the protagonist's immediate transformation feel rushed and lack explanation. The phrase "What I am now is a curse that has made me worse then being dead" is grammatically incorrect and doesn't clearly convey the character's new state.

c. Exemplar: "As the withered hands grasped me, I felt a strange transformation begin. My humanity slipped away, replaced by an unnatural immortality. I had become one of them—a fate worse than death, doomed to roam the world as the very monster I once feared."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the opening paragraph, focusing on introducing each character clearly and creating a smoother transition between boarding the ship and your first day's activities. Ensure you maintain consistency in the number of cousins mentioned and provide more details about the "zombie-like figure" you encountered.
