#1 (First paragraph): a. Strengths:

- Engaging opening that immediately captures attention
- Effective use of vivid imagery to set the scene
- b. Weaknesses: Abrupt transition The transition from Mozart's appearance to the principal's suggestion feels rushed and lacks proper setup. Your writing jumps from Mozart's confusion to the principal's proposal without providing necessary context or explanation. #2 (Third paragraph): a. Strengths:

- b. Weaknesses: Overuse of dialogue Your writing relies heavily on direct quotes from Mozart, which can disrupt the flow of the narrative. For example, the lengthy speech beginning with "This is our secret formula" could be condensed and partially paraphrased to maintain pacing.
- c. Exemplar: "Mozart unveiled his 'secret formula' to the bewildered team a diagram that resembled a musical score more than a soccer plan. He enthusiastically explained how each player represented an instrument in his grand symphony of victory."

#3 (Fifth paragraph): a. Strengths:

- Vivid description of the game's progression
- Effective use of musical terminology to describe soccer gameplay
- b. Weaknesses: Telling rather than showing Your writing tends to explicitly state what's happening rather than allowing the reader to visualise it through descriptive language. For instance, "The crowd watched in awe as the game unfolded like an orchestra symphony" tells the reader how to interpret the scene instead of showing it through specific details.

c. Exemplar: "The players' movements flowed with an uncanny grace, their passes precise and rhythmic. The opposition stumbled, struggling to keep up with this strange, melodic style of play that seemed to anticipate their every move."
