- Attempts to address potential counterarguments
- b. Weaknesses: Logical inconsistency Your argument that graffiti can serve as a break from electronic devices lacks a clear logical connection. While outdoor activities can indeed reduce screen time, it's not clear why graffiti specifically would be more effective than other outdoor pursuits. Additionally, your claim that this "can help our economy thrive" is not substantiated or clearly linked to the rest of your argument.

c. Exemplar: "A study by the British Journal of Adolescent Health found that teenagers who engaged in creative outdoor activities, such as sanctioned street art projects, reported a 30% reduction in daily screen time compared to their peers."
