## #1 (Opening paragraph): a. Strengths:

- Captivating opening scene that immediately grabs the reader's attention
- Creative premise of Mozart time-travelling to become a soccer coach
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Lack of detail and context Your opening paragraph rushes through the introduction of Mozart without providing sufficient context or detail. For instance, you write, "A strange man in 18th century clothing appeared in the middle of the hall. It was Mozart." This abrupt introduction leaves the reader with many questions about how and why Mozart appeared.
- c. Exemplar: "A blinding flash of light filled the hall, and as it faded, a man in elaborate 18th-century attire stood before them. His powdered wig and ornate coat were unmistakable somehow, impossibly, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart had appeared in their school."

## #2 (First practice session): a. Strengths:

- Clever integration of Mozart's musical background into soccer coaching
- Humorous misunderstanding of football as an instrument
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Unrealistic dialogue and reactions The dialogue and reactions in this section feel forced and unrealistic. For example, when Mozart asks, "This is the instrument we play with?", a child simply replies with an explanation, rather than expressing shock or confusion at Mozart's lack of knowledge.
- c. Exemplar: "Mozart stared at the spotted ball in bewilderment. 'Is this the instrument we play with?' he asked. The children exchanged puzzled glances. 'Instrument?' one finally sputtered. 'It's a football, sir. Haven't you ever seen one before?'"
- #3 (Final match and Mozart's departure): a. Strengths:
  - Vivid description of the team's performance during the match
  - Poignant departure of Mozart, maintaining the magical element
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Rushed conclusion Your conclusion feels rushed and lacks emotional impact. You write, "The children were too busy celebrating when they realised that their coach was gone," which doesn't fully capture the significance of Mozart's departure or its effect on the team.

c. Exemplar: "As the team's jubilant cheers filled the air, a familiar bright light enveloped Mozart. He smiled warmly at his young players, gave a final, graceful bow, and in a flash, he was gone. The children's celebration halted abruptly as they realised their beloved coach had vanished, leaving them with an extraordinary tale they'd cherish forever."

Actionable task: Rewrite the opening paragraph, focusing on creating a more gradual and detailed introduction of Mozart's appearance. Ensure you describe the setting more vividly and show the reactions of those present in greater detail.
