#1: (First paragraph) a. Strengths:

before him. With a bittersweet smile, he turned to his team. 'Remember,' he said, 'in music and in soccer, harmony is key.' Then, with a final bow, he stepped into the portal, vanishing from sight."

Ensure to include more detailed descriptions of the players' actions and emotions during this climactic scene.
