Section 1:

#1: (First paragraph) a. Strengths:

- Vivid imagery: "Her mind was a tornado of aggregating thoughts"
- Strong character introduction: Mia's passion for the park is clear
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Overuse of clichés Your writing relies heavily on clichés, which can make the prose feel unoriginal. Phrases like "jaw touched the ground" and "piggy, beady eyed developers drooling for money" are overused and don't effectively convey Mia's emotions or the developers' motivations.
- c. Exemplar: "Mia's heart raced as she read the headline: 'Urban development needed for Central Park'. The thought of concrete replacing the lush greenery made her stomach churn."

#2: (Third paragraph) a. Strengths:

- Introduces conflict: Shows opposition to Mia's cause
- Incorporates dialogue: Uses chanting to convey atmosphere
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Lack of detail and depth Your writing here lacks specificity and depth. The flash mob scene is rushed, and the "easy win" is not substantiated. The phrase "After that surprise, she gathered a lot of her supporters" doesn't provide enough detail about how Mia organised her response or what actions she took.
- c. Exemplar: "The next morning, Mia awoke to a cacophony of voices. Outside, a crowd had gathered, their chants echoing off the buildings: 'When do we want urban development?' 'NOW!' Mia's heart sank, but determination quickly took over. She reached for her phone, fingers flying as she messaged her supporters."

#3: (Last two paragraphs) a. Strengths:

- Provides resolution: Shows the outcome of Mia's efforts
- Introduces a twist: "But then, the evil developers came back"
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Rushed pacing and simplistic resolution Your writing here rushes through important events and provides an overly simplistic resolution. The phrase "Unable to take the pressure, he agreed to not have urban development in the park" doesn't realistically portray how such a significant decision would be made. The final twist feels abrupt and underdeveloped.

c. Exemplar: "After weeks of relentless campaigning, Mia's inbox pinged with a new message. It was from the mayor's office, announcing a town hall meeting to discuss the park's future. Mia felt a glimmer of hope - this was their chance to be heard."

Actionable task: Rewrite the third paragraph (#2), focusing on Mia's emotional journey and the specific steps she takes to organise her supporters. Ensure you include sensory details to bring the scene to life.
