Strengths:

Weaknesses: Vocabulary Integration —> The word 'clandestine' feels abruptly inserted and doesn't match the overall voice. The phrase "secret building" immediately after redundantly repeats the concept.

Exemplar: "The door creaked loudly, but the thunderous cheering drowned out the sound. Michael pressed his eye to the gap. 'They're having some kind of secret meeting!' he whispered."

Strengths:

- Your resolution promotes unity and compromise

Weaknesses: Resolution Development —> The conclusion feels rushed with the solution coming from an unnamed character. The villager's statement lacks emotional weight.

Exemplar: "'Why must we choose?' Old Mr Thompson called out from the crowd, his eyes twinkling. 'Our village has enough room to celebrate both!'"

Actionable Task: Rewrite the greenhouse discovery scene (when they find the pickles) and include specific sensory details about what they see, smell, and hear to make the moment more impactful.
