Section 1:

#1 (Opening paragraph): Strengths:

- Strong scene-setting with vivid sensory details of the developers and their actions
- Effective use of dialogue to create tension and reveal the plot conflict

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Point of View \rightarrow Your writing shifts between perspectives, particularly in describing Mia's observations. Phrases like "their malicious eyes seethed with greed" and "their potbellies were making them look like sumo wrestlers" feel disconnected from Mia's viewpoint.

#2 (Middle section about gathering votes): Strengths:

#3 (Climactic scene): Strengths:

- Creates genuine tension with the time pressure
- Shows satisfying resolution to the conflict

Weaknesses: Underdeveloped Resolution \rightarrow Your ending feels abrupt with phrases like "The developers were breath-taken at our underlying effort and decided to call of the construction." The developers' sudden change of heart needs more justification.

Exemplar: "The developers examined our petition, their expressions shifting from dismissal to surprise as they noted the influential names and sheer number of signatures. After a tense discussion, they announced their decision to preserve the park."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the middle section (gathering votes) by creating more obstacles and challenges in collecting signatures. Show specific encounters with different community members and their varied reactions.
