#1 (First paragraph): Strengths:

- Vivid sensory details in describing the developers ("corpulent, purpled frames", "pudgy yellowed eyes")
- Strong emotional language conveying Mia's reaction ("Untrammelled anger")

Weaknesses: Over-reliance on purple prose Your description of the developers relies heavily on exaggerated physical characteristics that border on caricature. Weaknesses: Underdeveloped conflict resolution Your transition from the protest scene to the developers' response feels rushed. The line "These kids don't understand economics" needs more context and development to show the real stakes of the conflict.

Exemplar: "The Times Square demonstration caught media attention, but the developers' dismissive response revealed how deeply entrenched their position was. 'These kids don't understand economics,' sneered one executive on the evening news, his words carrying the weight of decades of urban development priorities."

#3 (Final paragraph): Strengths:

- Effective use of nature imagery
- Satisfying resolution with compromise

Weaknesses: Rushed conclusion Your ending moves too quickly to the resolution without fully explaining how the compromise was reached. The phrase "funded by a compromise that had saved the park" glosses over what could be a compelling explanation of how both sides found common ground.

Exemplar: "The new playground stood as a testament to what could be achieved when development and preservation worked in harmony - a carefully negotiated compromise that had protected the park's essential character while allowing for thoughtful modernisation."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the confrontation scene between Mia and the developers, focusing on specific dialogue and actions that show their conflicting viewpoints rather than relying on physical descriptions to establish character.
