#3: "I know you or your child are feeling lonely, well this robot will be like a best friend to you! So, come to our shop and buy now!"

a. Strengths:

- You appeal to emotions by addressing potential loneliness, which could resonate with readers.
- You end with a clear call to action, encouraging readers to make a purchase.
- b. Weaknesses: Main issue: Oversimplification and lack of professionalism Your claim that the robot will be "like a best friend" oversimplifies complex emotional needs and may come across as insensitive. The abrupt transition to "So, come to our shop and buy now!" feels rushed and lacks the persuasive detail needed for such a significant purchase.
- c. Exemplar: "Our robots can provide companionship and support, potentially alleviating feelings of loneliness for both adults and children. Visit our shop to learn more about how these innovative assistants can enhance your daily life."
