## Section 1:

#1: The opening paragraph Strengths: a) Your vivid description of Mia's reaction creates an immediate sense of urgency. b) You effectively establish the setting in Central Park.

Weakness: Overuse of hyperbole Your opening relies heavily on exaggerated language, which can distract from the story's core message. For instance, "Mia's eyeballs popped out of their sockets" and "Central Park, the very heart of N.Y.C, will be lacerated by commercialization for all eternity" are overly dramatic. While these phrases grab attention, they may undermine the seriousness of the issue.

Exemplar: "Mia's eyes widened in shock as she reread the headline, her pace quickening as she navigated through Central Park. The news of potential commercialisation threatened to change the very heart of New York City forever."

#2: The developers' description Strengths: a) You create a clear visual image of the antagonists. b) The use of sensory details adds depth to the scene.

Weakness: Overreliance on negative stereotypes Your portrayal of the developers relies heavily on negative physical attributes and behaviours. This approach can come across as simplistic and potentially offensive. For example, "The developers' sustainers were almost snapping from the Brobdingnagian size of their malodourous bellies" focuses more on appearance than their actions or motivations.

Exemplar: "The developers huddled together, their voices rising with excitement as they discussed the potential profits. Their casual disregard for the park's wildlife was evident in the way they carelessly flicked cigarette ash onto the grass."

#3: Mia's response to the setback Strengths: a) You show Mia's determination in the face of obstacles. b) The dialogue adds realism to the scene.

Weakness: Lack of character development Your writing doesn't fully explore Mia's emotional journey or decision-making process. The transition from setback to action is abrupt, missing an opportunity to delve into Mia's thoughts and motivations. For instance, "Mia knew the answer" doesn't provide insight into her reasoning or the difficulty of her choice.

Exemplar: "Mia's heart raced as she considered their options. The weight of responsibility settled on her shoulders, but she knew they couldn't give up. 'We need to take this to the people,' she said, her voice steady despite her inner turmoil. 'It's time to rally the entire community.'"

Actionable task: Rewrite the paragraph describing the developers, focusing on their actions and motivations rather than their physical appearance. Consider how you can make them more nuanced antagonists while still conveying the threat they pose to Central Park.
