#### Section 1:

# #1 Opening Paragraph Strengths:

- Strong emotional hook with the tragic backstory of Rick's family
- Clear establishment of the main character's motivation for working at the mill

Weaknesses: Underdeveloped Character Introduction  $\rightarrow$  Your opening introduces multiple characters rapidly without giving readers time to connect with them. The line "His dad, grandma and grandpa were all killed in a car accident" feels abrupt and could benefit from more emotional depth. Consider how Rick feels about these losses.

Exemplar: "Rick's heart felt heavy as he approached the mill farm's entrance. Since losing his father, grandmother, and grandfather in the tragic accident last year, he had become the man of the house at just eleven years old."

# #2 The Confrontation Scene (paragraph 4) Strengths:

- Good use of action and dialogue to create tension
- Effective pacing during the chase sequence

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Tense Usage → Your writing shifts between past and present tense, particularly in phrases like "As he thinked" and "Now rick caught him and he has now where to go." This disrupts the flow of the action sequence.

Exemplar: "Rick's heart pounded as they raced through the garden, the angry man's footsteps thundering behind him. The children, hearing his cry for help, quickly formed a protective circle around their tormentor."

## #3 Resolution Scene (final paragraph) Strengths:

- Satisfying conclusion with both personal and community victory
- Good closure for Rick's character arc

Weaknesses: Rushed Ending  $\rightarrow$  Your ending compresses several important events into quick succession without giving them proper weight. The transition from "Rick thanked ivy" to suddenly having "a bag of money" feels too abrupt.

Exemplar: "Rick watched the children playing in the garden, their laughter a stark contrast to the gloomy mill of just hours ago. Ivy smiled warmly, reaching into her desk. 'Your bravery deserves recognition,' she said, presenting him with a bag of money that would help his family start anew."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the confrontation scene (paragraph 4), focusing specifically on maintaining consistent past tense throughout. As you revise, highlight each verb to ensure you're using the correct tense.
