

Section 1:

#1 (Opening paragraph) Strengths:

- Strong emotional opening that establishes character's nervousness
- Clear introduction of key characters and setting

Weaknesses: Underdeveloped Character Background → Your introduction of Rick's mother as CEO feels abrupt and needs more context. The line "because he was 11" doesn't effectively explain why he needs to help in the company.

Exemplar: "Rick's hands were shaking furiously as he reached for the chicken sandwich - his first attempt at the family business. As the son of Chicky restaurant's CEO, he felt the weight of expectations on his young shoulders."

#2 (Judge's evaluation scene) Strengths:

- Good use of suspense building
- Effective sensory details in describing the sandwich

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Pacing → Your description jumps too quickly from the judging to running home. The phrase "As soon as the test was over, he raced back home" leaves out important emotional reactions and transition.

Exemplar: "The judge's words - 'Very crunchy but slightly overcooked' - echoed in Rick's mind. With mixed feelings of relief and determination to improve, he headed home, his mind already planning his next attempt."

#3 (Competition scene) Strengths:

- Good build-up of tension
- Clear resolution and reward

Weaknesses: Rush to Conclusion → Your ending feels rushed with "When Rick became an adult, he became the CEO." The transition from winning the competition to becoming CEO needs more development.

Exemplar: "Rick's victory at the competition marked the beginning of his journey. Years later, when he took over as CEO of Chicky restaurant, that golden trophy still held pride of place in his office."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the competition scene (final paragraph) focusing on showing Rick's emotional journey from nervousness to triumph, incorporating specific details about how the judge's reaction made him feel.
