#1 - First paragraph Strengths:

#1 UKRAINE-RUSSIA WAR:

The third biggest war after WWI and WWII. Russia invaded Ukraine on February 24, 2022, launching a multi-attack on major Ukrainian cities, including Kyiv, Kharkiv, and Mariupol. Ukraine has pushed Russia back over time but is still under attack and is gradually gaining strength due to high-teeh systems and open-source intelligence (OSINT). The situation remains fluid, and peace talks have yet to yield any substantial results. Ukrainian General Valerii Zaluzhnyi, dubbed the "Iron General," played a crucial role in organizing [organising] Ukraine's resistance and counteroffensives. His leadership has earned him global recognition, drawing comparisons to historic military strategists.

#2 Ukraine's resilience has been commendable, as the nation's military forces adapt and employ innovative strategies to counteract the advantages held by the Russian army. The conflict underscores crucial issues surrounding the nation and the balance of power in the modern world, [This conflict has highlighted fundamental questions about national sovereignty and global power dynamics,] serving as a reminder of the fragile nature of peace and the enduring consequences of war.

The human costs have been devastating. Millions of Ukrainians have fled, creating Europe's largest refugee crisis since World War II. Civilians in cities like Mariupol and Bucha have suffered unimaginable destruction, with reports of war crimes, including mass killings.

#3 Many Middle Eastern countries have suffered as Ukraine has closed ports and not producing wheat even though they are one of the biggest wheat suppliers for Africa and Middle Eastern Africa. Also, Russia has stopped many ports in Ukraine as it is a threat to end products overseas. [The closure of Ukrainian ports and the disruption of wheat production have severely impacted Middle Eastern and African nations, which heavily depend on Ukrainian wheat supplies. Russia's blockade of Ukrainian ports has further exacerbated the crisis, threatening global supply chains and food security in these regions.]
