#1 First paragraph (Musical abilities) Strengths:

- Strong personal voice when describing musical experiences
- Effective use of specific examples demonstrating leadership and teamwork

Weaknesses: Lack of concrete impact \rightarrow While you mention participating in various musical ensembles, you don't clearly articulate the specific value you brought to these groups.
