

## Section 1:

### #1 (First paragraph) Strengths:

### #2 (Second paragraph) Strengths:

Weaknesses: Structural Coherence → Your sentence structure becomes unclear, especially in "More days went on the same except one stormy night Rick saw lots of people." The transition lacks smoothness.

Exemplar: "One stormy night broke the monotony when Rick noticed an unusual sight: crowds of people perched on their doorsteps, all absorbed in their phones playing Magic Jewel Pet."

### #3 (Final paragraph) Strengths:

- Meaningful resolution showing character growth
- Effective use of dialogue for emotional impact

Weaknesses: Dialogue Format → Your dialogue formatting needs attention, particularly in the spacing and punctuation of "he heard his phone barking, so he opened it"

Exemplar: "Rick heard his phone barking. With a smile, he opened it one last time and whispered, 'I don't need you anymore – I have a real friend now.'"

Actionable Task: Rewrite the first paragraph focusing on creating a clearer progression of Rick's emotional state, using varied sentence structures to show how his isolation affects him differently as time passes.
