Section 1:

#1: Opening paragraph Strengths:

- Strong scene-setting with the "cold icy morning" establishing atmosphere
- Effective introduction of the main character Rick and the plot catalyst

Weaknesses: Run-on Sentences → Your writing contains multiple ideas joined without proper punctuation or transitions, particularly in "So the children, one of them was Rick, started to pack..." Consider breaking these into clearer, distinct sentences.

Exemplar: "Rick was among the chosen children. With excitement, they began packing their clothes, toys, and other belongings for the train journey."

#2: Middle section (description of train journey) Strengths:

- Vivid sensory details about the food quality
- Good use of environmental descriptions with windmills and wheat farms

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Tense Usage \rightarrow Your narrative shifts between past and present tense: "Time passed and they got their first meal" then "Next was time to eat the had nice fresh warm bread." This disrupts the story flow.

Exemplar: "Time passed slowly until their first meal arrived. They received a slice of rock-hard meatloaf and a cup of warm water."

#3: Final paragraph Strengths:

- Emotional depth in describing Rick's disappointment
- Satisfying resolution with the surprise adoption

Weaknesses: Rushed Pacing \rightarrow Your ending feels hurried, particularly in "as he heard footsteps coming after him." The emotional impact could be stronger with more developed moments.

Exemplar: "As Rick trudged back to the train, tears streaming down his face, unexpected footsteps echoed behind him. He turned to find a lady holding flowers, her warm smile offering hope he had almost abandoned."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the train journey sequence focusing on Rick's emotional state during each failed adoption attempt. Include specific details about his thoughts and feelings rather than just stating he was "upset" or "crying."
