Section 1:

#1 (First paragraph) Strengths:

- Effective emotional appeal through vivid imagery of animals in nature
- Strong hook with rhetorical question about a world without animals

Weaknesses: Unfocused Structure \rightarrow Your opening paragraph combines multiple distinct ideas without clear transitions. The sudden shift from discussing animal extinction to rubbish disposal disrupts the flow. "Also, we should stop wasting rubbish" introduces a new topic abruptly.

Exemplar: "Imagine a world devoid of animal life - no monkeys swinging through trees, no pandas munching bamboo, no birds soaring overhead. Such a world would devastate our ecosystem's delicate balance. To prevent this grim future, we must act now."

#2 (Third paragraph) Strengths:

- Compelling example with turtle mistaking plastic for jellyfish
- Clear cause-and-effect relationship between waste and animal harm

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Tense Usage \rightarrow You switch between present and past tenses. "Turtels swimming" then "said the turtle" creates confusion. The narrative needs consistent tense throughout.

Exemplar: "A turtle swims in the ocean, spotting what appears to be a jellyfish. Tragically, it's actually a plastic bag - a mistake that could prove fatal."

#3 (Final paragraph) Strengths:

- Strong concluding statement linking environmental care to human welfare
- Effective summary of main points

Weaknesses: Repetitive Phrasing \rightarrow Your conclusion repeats phrases like "make a difference" and "sign a paper" without developing ideas further. The ending needs more sophisticated synthesis.

Exemplar: "Our actions today will determine the future health of our planet's ecosystem. By reducing waste, protecting habitats, and advocating for change, we can ensure a thriving Earth for generations to come."

Actionable Task: Rewrite your opening paragraph focusing on one main idea (either animal extinction or waste management) and develop it fully before transitioning to the next topic.

Section 2:
