

## Section 1:

### #1 - Opening Paragraph Strengths:

- Effectively establishes Rick's initial confusion and unfamiliarity with kitchen equipment
- Shows character development through his growing curiosity

Weaknesses: Underdeveloped Scene Setting → Your opening lacks specific details about the kitchen environment and fails to create a strong visual image. Phrases like "huge machines" and "bizarre terminologies" are vague and could be replaced with specific kitchen equipment names and culinary terms.

Exemplar: "When Rick stepped into the industrial kitchen, the gleaming steel surfaces of mixers, ovens, and food processors overwhelmed him. His mother's words - terms like 'blanching' and 'mise en place' - only deepened his confusion."

### #2 - Competition Scene Strengths:

- Creates excitement through the sandwich competition concept
- Incorporates creative elements like the "crunch meter"

Weaknesses: Plot Consistency → Your narrative jumps too quickly from Rick learning about kitchen equipment to becoming an expert sandwich maker. The phrase "now since rick knew how to do everything" needs more development to show how he gained this expertise.

Exemplar: "After weeks of practising with each piece of equipment and perfecting his technique, Rick felt ready to tackle the sandwich competition."

### #3 - Conclusion Strengths:

- Includes a satisfying victory moment
- Shows the impact of Rick's achievement

Weaknesses: Logical Flow → Your ending becomes unrealistic with phrases like "1 google" and the sudden shift to giving away free sandwiches. The conclusion needs a more grounded resolution that maintains the story's credibility.

Exemplar: "Their sandwich became so popular that they opened their own shop, sharing their creation with the neighbourhood while maintaining a successful business."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the middle section focusing on Rick's learning journey - show specific moments where he masters each piece of equipment and develops his sandwich-making skills.
