## #1 (First paragraph): Strengths:

- Strong opening with a thought-provoking question that engages readers
- Creative use of future perspective to emphasise environmental concerns

Weaknesses: Inconsistent Voice and Tone  $\rightarrow$  Your narrative switches between present and future perspectives, which creates confusion. Your opening states "I have come as a global citizen from 2060" but then shifts to present-day concerns. Your phrases like "have you ever wondered" and "I have seen the answer" need better connection to maintain the time-traveller perspective.

Exemplar: "As a visitor from 2060, I've witnessed the devastating reality of what happens when we ignore our planet's health. In my time, our oceans overflow with waste, wildlife exists only in digital archives, and clean air has become a luxury few can afford."

## #2 (Second paragraph): Strengths:

- Effective use of specific examples to illustrate environmental damage
- Strong emotional appeal through vivid imagery

Weaknesses: Structural Organisation  $\rightarrow$  Your ideas jump between different environmental issues without clear transitions. Your discussion moves from "plastic clogging oceans" to "landfills" to "drinking water" without establishing clear connections. The paragraph needs stronger linking phrases to guide readers through these related but distinct problems.

Exemplar: "In 2060, our negligence has created a devastating chain reaction: plastics choke our oceans, decimating marine ecosystems, while expanding landfills devour what little remains of our forests and farmland."

# #3 (Final paragraph): Strengths:

- Powerful call to action that emphasises individual responsibility
- Effective use of empowering language to motivate readers

Weaknesses: Message Coherence  $\rightarrow$  Your concluding message combines too many ideas without clear focus. Your statements about "eco logical knowledge," "separating trash," and "rewriting history" need better organisation to create a more impactful closing argument.

Exemplar: "Your actions today will shape our world in 2060. By embracing recycling and sustainable practices now, you're not just managing waste – you're preserving hope for future generations. The power to rewrite our future lies in your hands."

Actionable Task: Rewrite your entire piece while maintaining consistent perspective as a time traveller from 2060, ensuring each statement reflects that future viewpoint rather than mixing present and future perspectives.
