### Section 1:

#1 (First paragraph about Mudgee's landscape) Strengths:

- Strong sense of place through vivid environmental details like "rolling hills" and birds twittering
- Effective use of sensory details to create atmosphere

Weaknesses: Run-on Sentences  $\rightarrow$  Your writing contains several lengthy sentences without proper punctuation, making it difficult to follow the flow of ideas. For instance: "Today, I went to Mudgee rolling hills and quiet lands it hadn't changed since the last time I saw it" needs proper punctuation and structure.

Exemplar: "Today, I visited Mudgee's rolling hills and quiet lands. Little had changed since my last visit, except for the developing irrigation system and the introduction of agricultural drones."

#2 (Meeting with Mr Rick Assely) Strengths:

- Clear presentation of specific development proposals
- Detailed financial figures showing thorough planning

Weaknesses: Sentence Structure Coherence  $\rightarrow$  Your ideas jump between topics without smooth transitions. The sentence "I was talking to him about one of my ideas is to spend" demonstrates this issue with its awkward construction.

Exemplar: "In my discussion with Mr Rick Assely, I proposed investing a quarter of a billion dollars in a generator capable of extracting ores and precious stones from the earth."

#3 (School visit) Strengths:

- Well-organised progression of ideas
- Effective balance between technological and environmental aspects

Weaknesses: Redundant Information  $\rightarrow$  Your conclusion repeats ideas without adding new information: "These intelligent minds of Mudgee needed more development" restates what was already implied.

Exemplar: "The school's transformation reflects Mudgee's commitment to combining technological advancement with environmental consciousness."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the first paragraph, breaking it into shorter, clearer sentences. Focus on using proper punctuation after each complete thought and creating smoother transitions between ideas.
