Strengths:

Weakness - Inconsistent Tense → Your piece shifts between past and present tense, creating confusion. "As the day sadly past" and "this how I knew" demonstrate this inconsistency.

Exemplar: "As the day sadly passed, I found myself with more questions than answers. This is how I discovered that the world is more complex than we think. On an icy morning, my friend John and I were exploring a forest known in legend to hold the most precious beast."

Strengths:

- Builds dramatic tension with the ground-shaking event
- Introduces fantastical elements creatively

Weakness - Run-on Sentences → Your sentences merge multiple ideas without proper punctuation or conjunctions. The sequence of events becomes difficult to follow.

Exemplar: "Then the ground began to shake, and we were separated by a giant crack that appeared in the middle, throwing him towards the mountain. A mythical creature guarded the peak, and suddenly, a phoenix and other beasts appeared in the sky."

#3 "But sadly, before I could say good bye to my favorite animal john tie a rope and bolted straight back home. No!! I stare at the him and I put him outside with the spider and other creature to punished him."

Strengths:

- Shows emotional investment in the story's conclusion
- Creates a clear sense of conflict between characters

Weakness - Unclear Character Motivation → Your ending lacks clear explanation of John's sudden actions and the narrator's extreme response.

Exemplar: "Before I could bid farewell to my favourite animal, John hastily tied a rope and bolted straight back home. Devastated by his betrayal, I watched him flee, deciding he deserved to spend time with the spiders and other creatures as consequence."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the first paragraph focusing on maintaining consistent past tense throughout, and ensure each sentence connects logically to the next by adding appropriate transitions.
