

Section 1:

Strengths:

Strengths:

Strengths:

- Creates vivid imagery through dynamic verbs

Exemplar: "Light sparked and whizzed before my eyes, unveiling ancient visions of Earth's molten birth and the first stirrings of life in primordial seas."
