#1 - Opening Paragraph Strengths:

- Your opening statistic about AI's impact creates a compelling hook that immediately draws readers in
- Your vivid imagery of hands with cuts and wrinkles effectively humanises the issue

Weakness: Underdeveloped Transition → Your transition from statistics to imagery is abrupt. When you write "Their hands, infected with cuts and wrinkles," the connection to the previous sentences isn't clear enough to fully support your argument.

Exemplar: "As AI displaces workers across industries, many find themselves facing financial insecurity, their worn hands testament to years of labour now deemed obsolete."

#2 - UBI Definition Paragraph Strengths:

- Your clear definition of UBI helps readers understand the core concept
- Your inclusion of real-world examples adds credibility to your argument

Weakness: Limited Development → Your discussion of previous UBI trials lacks specific details about their outcomes. When you mention "it was only implemented for 1 to 3 years," you could strengthen this by exploring why these trials ended.

Exemplar: "While several countries have conducted UBI trials, including the United States and China, these programmes, though promising, were limited to short-term experiments lasting between one to three years, leaving crucial questions about long-term viability."

#3 - Benefits Paragraph Strengths:

- Your concrete example of \$2000 monthly payments makes the concept tangible
- Your connection between UBI and education opportunities is well-reasoned

Weakness: Incomplete Analysis → Your discussion of poverty reduction could be more thorough. When you write "More perks are poverty reduction," you've identified an important benefit but haven't fully explored its implications.

Exemplar: "Beyond immediate poverty reduction, UBI's monthly payment of \$2000 would create a foundation for social mobility, allowing families to invest in education and skill development."

Actionable Task: Rewrite your opening paragraph focusing on creating smoother transitions between your statistical evidence and personal examples, ensuring each sentence flows naturally into the next while maintaining your powerful imagery.
