

Section 1:

#1 (Opening segment with host introduction and initial dialogue) Strengths:

- Effective establishment of setting and context through natural dialogue
- Clear introduction of key characters and their roles

Weaknesses: Dialogue Structure → Your opening dialogue lacks proper formatting and punctuation. The exchanges between "Host:" and "Ana:" need clearer separation and proper quotation marks, as seen in "Host: Hello and welcome back to the daily news."

Exemplar: "Welcome back to the daily news," Sarah began, adjusting her microphone. "Today, we're joined by Ana, one of the remarkable Mongolian dancers who recently stunned tourists with their Brazilian street performance."

#2 (Description of costumes and outfits) Strengths:

- Vivid use of colour imagery to paint a picture
- Detailed description of individual costume elements

Weaknesses: Consistency in Detail → Your description varies in depth throughout the passage. While you thoroughly describe Ana's outfit, the descriptions of other dancers' costumes are less detailed, as seen in "My other friend had a blue and purple leotard."

Exemplar: "Each dancer's costume told its own story. Mine featured a pink, orange and yellow leotard adorned with a delicate tutu, whilst Maria wore an intricately designed blue and purple ensemble that complemented our collective vision."

#3 (Musical performance description) Strengths:

- Strong sensory details in describing the music
- Effective use of metaphors to convey energy

Weaknesses: Sentence Flow → Your sentences about the musical performance contain repetitive structures and abrupt transitions, as seen in "It was amazing! Every single musical instrument..."

Exemplar: "The performance merged countless instruments into a harmonious blend, with steady drumbeats providing foundation whilst the piano wove intricate melodies throughout."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the musical performance segment, focusing on creating smoother transitions between sentences and varying your sentence structures to improve flow.
