Section 1:

#1 (Introduction paragraph) Strengths:

- Effective build-up of anticipation through the revelation of travel plans
- Clear sequence of events leading to arrival at the destination

Weaknesses: Event rushing \rightarrow Your narrative moves too quickly through important moments without giving readers time to absorb the significance. For instance, "went to the airport, on the plane and hours later, landed in Singapore" compresses what could be meaningful travel experiences into a single rushed line.

Exemplar: "The anticipation built as we made our way through the bustling airport, and before we knew it, we were soaring high above the clouds, watching the world beneath us transform into a patchwork of colours."

#2 (Body Paragraph 1) Strengths:

- Vivid details about the hotel's features
- Effective use of specific details like "white gloves" to create imagery

Weaknesses: Structural coherence \rightarrow Your paragraph jumps between different events without smooth transitions. The shift from "Two guys in white gloves came and brought our bags" to "In the meantime, we all decided to explore" feels abrupt and disconnected.

Exemplar: "As the porters in their pristine white gloves carefully handled our luggage, we seized the opportunity to begin our exploration of this magnificent establishment."

#3 (Body Paragraph 2) Strengths:

- Engaging sensory details about the food
- Strong emotional response to the dining experience

Weaknesses: Repetitive phrasing \rightarrow Your writing relies heavily on similar sentence structures and repeated ideas. The phrases "so good" and "we wanted to go back" express the same sentiment without adding new information.

Exemplar: "The aromatic spices and freshly baked naan created such an extraordinary dining experience that we found ourselves ordering seconds, our taste buds still craving more long after we had finished."

Actionable task: Rewrite your introduction paragraph, focusing on creating detailed moments for each stage of the journey - the preparation, the departure, and the arrival. Take time to describe at least one specific detail from each of these stages.
