Exemplar: "Lost and exhausted, we stumbled through the darkening woods until we spotted a magnificent sight - a unicorn whose coat shimmered with every colour of the rainbow. Its gentle eyes met ours, and somehow we knew it had come to our rescue."

Strengths:

Weaknesses: Underdeveloped Resolution → Your ending feels abrupt and doesn't fully explore the impact of your magical experience. The phrase "wasn't going to have an adventurous journey like that" suggests finality without explaining why.

Exemplar: "As John and I emerged from the enchanted forest, the ordinary world seemed somehow different. The magic we'd witnessed had changed us forever, opening our eyes to the extraordinary possibilities that might lie behind even the most ordinary-looking trees."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the unicorn encounter paragraph, focusing on developing a more detailed sequence of events that shows how you and John interact with the magical creature. Include specific details about your emotions and the unicorn's appearance.
