#### Section 1:

Try adding more details about how the storms affect people and why they're dangerous. Your ending feels rushed - take time to show Carol's transformation and what the light means. Focus on connecting your ideas more smoothly to help readers follow the story better.

Actionable Task: Rewrite the scene where Carol encounters the white light, focusing on building tension gradually and clearly showing how it affects her physically and mentally.
