Section 1:

Strengths:

Weakness: Repetitive word choice  $\rightarrow$  Your use of "celestial" twice in close proximity weakens the impact. The second instance could be replaced with different imagery.

Weakness: Run-on sentence without proper punctuation  $\rightarrow$  This part combines multiple ideas without proper connection. The phrase "not biased or opinionated with specific student" is unclear and disrupts the flow.

## Exemplar: "To me, being a good student means caring for others, not just yourself. It means treating everyone fairly and respectfully, without showing favouritism towards particular students."

#2 "When I see my peers being treated unfairly, I will use the "high five" which is speak politely, speak firmly, ignore, walk away and reporting to a teacher."

Strengths:

- Demonstrates knowledge of conflict resolution steps
- Shows structured thinking in handling difficult situations

Weakness: Inconsistent verb forms  $\rightarrow$  The list mixes different verb forms ("speak," "ignore," "reporting"). The steps need clearer organisation.

## Exemplar: "When I see my peers being treated unfairly, I follow the 'high five' steps: speaking politely, speaking firmly, ignoring the situation, walking away, and reporting to a teacher."

#3 "The historical figure will definitely be Napoleon because he conquered many countries in Europe in the Napoleonic era and stood as an admiring figure in my heart"

Strengths:

- Shows personal connection to historical figure
- Provides specific reason for choice

Weakness: Limited depth in reasoning  $\rightarrow$  The response focuses mainly on conquest without exploring Napoleon's leadership qualities or specific achievements.

# Exemplar: "I would choose Napoleon because he demonstrated remarkable leadership during the European campaigns. His ability to overcome defeats and maintain determination particularly inspires me."

■ Your answers would benefit from more detailed examples to support your points. When discussing being a good student, you could mention specific ways to show care for others. For the unfair treatment situation, you might describe a real scenario where you used the "high five" steps. Your Napoleon answer could include specific battles or reforms he implemented. Try to make your responses longer by adding these concrete details.
