#2: "The first creature I encountered was a shimmering fox... leaving behind only a faint fragrance of lavender and pine."

## Strengths:

- Your detailed characterisation of the fox creates a magical atmosphere
- Your inclusion of sensory details enhances the scene's authenticity

Weakness: Unclear Temporal Flow  $\rightarrow$  Your passage jumps between different moments without smooth transitions. The phrase "Before I could even think to approach" feels abrupt after the detailed description of the fox's eyes.

Exemplar: "As I stood transfixed by its sapphire eyes, the mysterious fox dissolved into glittering dust, leaving only traces of lavender and pine hanging in the air."

#3: "As I walk out of the Enchanted Forest... I look up at the sky and watch the flock of golden griffins fly away."

## Strengths:

Weakness: Tense Inconsistency  $\rightarrow$  Your writing shifts between past and present tense. You begin with "As I walk" (present tense) but earlier used past tense throughout the narrative.

Exemplar: "As I walked out of the Enchanted Forest, soft blue hues morphed into a tapestry of magenta and crimson across the sky."

Actionable Task: Rewrite your final paragraph maintaining consistent past tense throughout, whilst ensuring smooth transitions between your descriptions of the sky and your emotional reflection.
