#1 Host's Opening Response Strengths:

- Effectively establishes personal connection through childhood memories
- Good use of sensory details with "magnificent dances" and "delicious kick"

Exemplar: "My parents' Mongolian heritage inspired me to create something truly unique - imagine Brazilian dancers performing against the backdrop of the Gobi Desert, while traditional Mongolian throat singers joined our samba beats."

#3 Description of the Event Strengths:

- Good use of sensory details with sounds and smells
- Nice inclusion of specific food descriptions
