Section 1:

#1 (First paragraph): Strengths:

- Clear thesis statement presenting three main arguments
- Strong opening question to engage audience

Weaknesses: Issue: Lack of compelling hook → Your opening question lacks impact and doesn't effectively draw listeners in. "Have you ever wondered why white is the standard colour?" doesn't create enough curiosity or urgency about the topic.

Your opening could be: "Imagine a world where every piece of paper you touch brings the calming essence of nature into your daily life. That world is possible if we make green the standard colour for A4 paper."

#2 (Second paragraph): Strengths:

- Good use of sensory details about nature
- Effective connection to relatable experiences

Weaknesses: Issue: Underdeveloped argument \rightarrow Your comparison to nature needs more specific examples and evidence. Simply stating "doesn't it feel good to your eyes" isn't convincing enough. You need to explain why green paper would be better for eye strain than white paper.

For example: "Studies have shown that looking at the colour green can reduce eye strain by up to 40%. By switching to green paper, we could make reading and writing more comfortable for everyone."

#3 (Third paragraph): Strengths:

- Attempts to address environmental concerns
- Links to current sustainability trends

Weaknesses: Issue: Inaccurate information \rightarrow Your claims about the manufacturing process are incorrect. You state "it is made by collecting pieces of white paper which were recycled and then they mush it with special green dye" without any factual basis.

Rather write: "Green paper can be produced using eco-friendly dyes and recycled materials, making it a more sustainable choice than bleached white paper."

■ Your speech needs stronger evidence to support your claims. Currently, you make statements without backing them up with facts or logical reasoning. Try to include specific examples of how green paper could benefit students in the classroom. You could also make your speech more persuasive by addressing potential counterarguments about why people might prefer white paper.

Actionable task: Rewrite your third paragraph focusing on verified environmental benefits of coloured paper production, and include at least two specific examples with proper reasoning.
