Section 1:

#1 (First paragraph) Strengths:

- Rich sensory details in describing the forest environment
- Creative use of personification with "tall oak trees guard"

Weaknesses: Inconsistent punctuation and spacing → Your writing shows missing spaces after full stops: "magical.The" and "pride.Birds". This disrupts the flow of reading. Also, there are spacing issues in the colour sequence "Red ,orange".

Exemplar: Today, I commenced my journey at the forest's edge. Tall oak trees stood guard proudly. Every step felt mystical and magical. The ocean-like sky wrapped around the forest, while the smiling sun gleamed with pride.

#2 (Dragon encounter) Strengths:

- Engaging build-up of suspense with "ROAR!"
- Creative incorporation of fantasy elements

Weaknesses: Abrupt transition and tense inconsistency \rightarrow Your writing switches between past and present tense: "I remember seeing" vs "it was". The introduction of the dragon feels sudden without proper context or description of your emotional response.

#3 (Nature school paragraph) Strengths:

- Creative metaphor of trees as teachers
- Imaginative personification of nature

Weaknesses: Spelling and clarity errors → Your writing contains misspellings like "every" instead of "everywhere" and "tails" instead of "tales". The phrase "learning and confusion amongst them" needs more context.

Exemplar: The whispering trees were everywhere, telling wise tales and sharing ancient knowledge. Like students in nature's school, the small leaves listened intently as elder trees passed down their wisdom.

→ Your diary entry shows wonderful creativity and imagination in describing a magical forest setting. However, you could develop your ideas further by adding more emotional responses to

the extraordinary events you witness. The transitions between different scenes need smoothing out, and some descriptions could be more detailed. You might consider expanding each encounter to build a richer narrative.

Actionable task: Rewrite the dragon encounter paragraph, focusing on your emotional reactions and providing more vivid details about how the dragon's appearance changed the forest atmosphere.
