### Section 1:

#1 "Adam was strolling along his neighbourhood, with his dog Nancy... So when he walked right into the time travel portal, he immediately noticed that something was going on."

Strengths:

- Good opening scene setting with clear introduction of main characters
- Nice build-up of tension before the time travel event

Weakness: Limited sensory details  $\rightarrow$  Your writing could be more vivid by including how the bush looked, felt, or smelled. For example, in "walked into the bush", you could describe the texture of branches or leaves brushing against Adam.

Exemplar: The thick, prickly branches scratched against Adam's arms as he pushed through the mysterious bush, Nancy's excited barks echoing behind him.

#2 "Adam tried communicating with the cavemen... Adam said bye to the caveman because it was time for him to go back home."

Strengths:

- Creative inclusion of modern technology (phone translator)
- Interesting interaction between past and present elements

Weakness: Rushed plot development  $\rightarrow$  Your story moves too quickly through important moments. The teaching of electronics to cavemen needs more detail about what exactly Adam taught them and how they learned.

# Exemplar: Adam spent hours showing the amazed cavemen how to connect simple circuits using stones and metal pieces they gathered, their eyes lighting up with each successful attempt.

#3 "Adam ran and ran and ran... She shouted you are grounded until you are 1000 years old."

Strengths:

- Good attempt at creating a resolution
- Interesting twist with meeting himself

Weakness: Underdeveloped ending  $\rightarrow$  Your ending feels rushed and doesn't fully explain how Adam's actions in the past affected the future. The grounding punishment seems disconnected from the main story.

## Exemplar: As Adam faced his mother's anger, he realised that his time-travelling adventure had taught him an important lesson about the dangers of changing the past.

■ Your story has an exciting premise about time travel, but needs more depth in describing key events and their consequences. Try adding more details about how the cavemen react to modern technology and what specific changes Adam sees in the future. Your characters could show more feelings and thoughts during these big moments.

Actionable task: Rewrite the scene where Adam teaches the cavemen about electronics, focusing on describing their specific reactions and the exact steps of what he teaches them.
