#1 (First paragraph) Strengths:

- Effective use of sensory details to establish the setting
- Strong imagery with "ancient trees stretching high"

#3 (Fourth paragraph) Strengths:

- Vivid colour descriptions of the mushrooms
- Engaging tactile imagery with "warmth up your fingers"

Weakness: Repetitive Sentence Structure \rightarrow Your paragraph begins multiple phrases with similar constructions, particularly with "Their." This creates a monotonous rhythm in the writing.

Exemplar: "Scattered across the forest floor, mushrooms emanated a faint glow, their caps displaying an array of colours from deep sapphire to fiery crimson."
