Strengths:

Exemplar: "Today I had THE BEST DAY EVER! My dream was to visit the enchanted forest. Since it was my birthday, my parents surprised me with a visit there. It was amazing, except for a few parts."

Strengths:

- Effective use of dialogue-like expressions
- Good sequence of events showing cause and effect

Weakness: Inconsistent Punctuation \rightarrow Your writing switches between proper punctuation and informal expressions without clear structure. "NOOOOOO!!!!" followed by "So we took a taxi" creates an uneven flow in your narrative.

Exemplar: "We planned to take the bus because our car broke down, but we just missed it. 'No!' I wailed. Thankfully, we managed to get a taxi instead, though it wasn't perfect - it smelled terrible and my sister Hannah became ill."

#3 "The obstacle course looked simple but it was the complicated one my cousins went on and one one of them fell off and broke their arm and leg. Her name was Ella and had to stay in hospital for a week."

Strengths:

- Good build-up of tension
- Effective use of personal experience to create context

Weakness: Sentence Structure \rightarrow Your writing contains repeated conjunctions ("and") and lacks proper clause separation. The sentence about your cousin Ella needs clearer structure.

Exemplar: "The obstacle course appeared simple at first glance, but it was actually the complicated one where my cousin Ella had fallen off, breaking both her arm and leg. She had to stay in hospital for a week after that incident."
