Exemplar: "The cold, musty air enveloped me as I ventured deeper, each step echoing against the ancient walls. My heart thundered in my chest as I steeled myself for what lay ahead."

#2 "The trees whispered to each other in some ancient language, and not a single animal was to be seen." Strengths:

- Your personification of trees adds mystical elements
- Your observation about the absence of animals creates intrigue

Weaknesses: Limited Sensory Integration  $\rightarrow$  Your description focuses solely on sound and sight, missing opportunities for a fuller sensory experience. The phrase "whispered to each other" could be enhanced with additional environmental details.

Exemplar: "The trees conversed in hushed, ancient whispers whilst their leaves rustled against the misty air, creating an eerie stillness where no creature dared venture."

#3 "As I ventured deeper into the forest, I spotted bioluminescent fungi, growing out of the ground. It glowed with a dim, blue, mysterious light." Strengths:

- Your incorporation of magical elements enhances the otherworldly setting
- Your specific details about the fungi's appearance create clear imagery

Weaknesses: Sentence Structure Variation  $\rightarrow$  Your consecutive simple sentences reduce the writing's flow. The phrases "growing out of the ground" and "glowed with a dim, blue, mysterious light" could be combined for better rhythm.

Exemplar: "Venturing deeper into the forest, I discovered bioluminescent fungi emerging from the earth, casting an ethereal blue glow that danced mysteriously through the darkness."

Actionable Task: Rewrite the cave entrance paragraph, focusing on incorporating all five senses whilst maintaining a steady pace that builds tension gradually.
