Strengths: Your conclusion brings the story full circle with Dr. Lila's personal growth. The storm metaphor connects well with the actual storm in the story.

Weakness: Overstated emotion → The realisation feels sudden and pronounced rather than earned through the character's journey. Phrases like "something stirred deep within" and "love—and compassion—that will prevail" sound generic rather than specific to Dr. Lila's unique experience. The excessive punctuation (ellipses, dashes, exclamation mark) makes the emotion feel forced rather than authentic.

The story structure needs strengthening, particularly in the middle sections where events seem to pile up without clear connections. Try focusing on fewer patients but exploring their stories more deeply. The storm arrives quite suddenly in the narrative; you could build tension by having characters notice the darkening sky earlier. Your dialogue is natural and helps bring characters to life, but adding more specific conversations would make interactions more memorable. Consider what makes Dr. Lila unique compared to other medical heroes in stories—perhaps a specific technique she uses or a personal connection to Willowbrook that deepens her commitment. Additionally, the ending would be stronger if Dr. Lila's realisation came from a specific moment with a patient rather than a general observation. Focus on making every scene show Dr. Lila's growth rather than simply telling readers she's changed.
