Strengths:

Strengths:

Strengths:

• Your story has an imaginative concept with the teleportation superpower, which shows creativity. However, the plot moves too quickly without developing important moments. Try expanding on how the character feels when they first discover their teleportation ability. What exactly happens during the teleportation? What does it feel like?

Your narrative would benefit from clearer paragraphs to separate different events in the story. Also, you could develop the homeless person as a character rather than just someone to help. What is their name? What is their story?

The ending needs more thought about consequences. Taking dad's wallet raises questions about where money comes from. Perhaps your character could earn money through chores or use their teleportation power in a clever way to help.

Additionally, consider what happens after helping one homeless person. Could your character create a longer-term plan to help more people with this amazing power?
