

Section 1:

#1: "In Sydney there was the opera house I could feel the hard cement and smell the delicious food that made my mouth started watering into pieces." Strengths:

- Good use of sensory details (touch, smell)
- Creates a vivid picture of your experience

Weakness: Flow of ideas → Your ideas jump quickly between the Opera House and food without clear links. The phrase "watering into pieces" needs more clarity.

Exemplar: *At the Sydney Opera House, I ran my hands along the hard cement walls while the smell of delicious food from nearby restaurants made my mouth water.*

#2: "Then I could hear the music it trying to make me dance and I could touch the cold summery breeze from my till my tippee toes" Strengths:

- Nice combination of sound and touch
- Shows your happy feelings about Sydney

Weakness: Word order → The words are a bit mixed up, making it hard to understand how the breeze affects you.

Exemplar: *The music made me want to dance while the cool summer breeze touched me from head to toe.*

#3: "if you were me and you are from Pakistan then you must try this food called chicken65 Biryani because it may like it if you are spice lover and it is in auburn" Strengths:

- Shares personal food recommendations
- Connects your background to the story

Weakness: Organisation → Your food suggestion comes suddenly without a proper lead-in. The location needs more details.

Exemplar: *As someone from Pakistan, I highly recommend trying the spicy Chicken65 Biryani at the restaurant in Auburn.*

■ Your piece shows great potential in sharing your experiences in Sydney. You have included many interesting details about what you saw, heard, and felt. To make your writing better, try organising your thoughts into clear paragraphs. Start with describing the Opera House in one

paragraph. Then, talk about the weather and atmosphere in another paragraph. Finally, share your food experiences in a separate paragraph. Also, try adding more details about your school memories since you mentioned it was your favourite. Additionally, you can tell us more about what made Carlingford Public School special to you. Remember to connect your ideas smoothly using words like 'then', 'after that', or 'next'. Your writing is quite short. Try to make your writing a bit longer by adding all these suggested improvements.
