Consider adding more diverse, realistic actions that address different aspects of animal protection.

***First, let's plant native trees that support local wildlife; even adding one or two to your garden helps. Next, learn about proper tree care for your climate (some trees need weekly rather than daily watering). Finally, join our community conservation group where we can share gardening tips and organise larger planting events together.***

#3 "Consider reducing meat consumption, limiting it to a small amount of pork or seafood each week. This will help protect animals and encourage healthier eating habits. As individuals, let's limit our intake of meat, poultry, or seafood to just a few times a week."

Strengths: You connect personal choices to broader environmental impact. The suggestion is specific and measurable rather than vague.

Weaknesses: Unclear connection to animal welfare → Your email doesn't explain how reducing meat consumption specifically helps wildlife habitat protection, which was your opening concern. The shift from habitat destruction to dietary choices needs a clearer connection. Additionally, singling out pork as preferable without explanation might confuse readers.

■ Your email shows genuine concern for animals but needs better organisation to be truly effective. The opening grabs attention but quickly moves between different ideas without clear connections. Try dividing your content into clearer sections: first explain the problem, then offer your solutions grouped by type (gardening actions, food choices, community involvement). Your suggestions need more depth—for example, explain why planting trees helps animals specifically. Also, try adding a personal story about why you care about this issue to help readers connect. Be careful about making claims without support, like suggesting that everyone is "part of a problem." Instead, invite people to be part of the solution in a friendly way. Your closing becomes confusing with phrases like "a percentage from zero till one hundred"—try ending with a simple, clear call to action instead.
