Weakness: Unclear metaphor connection  $\rightarrow$  Your comparison between love and "a pool in a hot humid day" feels disconnected from the bed metaphor. The phrases "everlasting happiness" and "immense joy" are too vague and don't show specific feelings or experiences. In your first sentence, "Love is a soft warm cozy bed of everlasting happiness with the sensation like a pool in a hot humid day," you're mixing two different metaphors without explaining how they relate.

Exemplar: Love is a soft warm cozy bed that wraps around you with comfort, similar to how cool water refreshes you on a sweltering summer day.

The phrase "death shooters" when describing the sun is unclear and doesn't convey a specific image. In "The ocean is a calm pool of liquid with waves," you're saying the ocean is calm but also has waves, which doesn't make sense together.

Exemplar: The ocean is a gentle giant, its cooling waves inviting us to play while respecting its power.

#3 "A shopping centre is a mall of fun and food which power you. A home is a building of sweet joy. An apartment is a building made of thousands of hearts of happiness. A school is a place where many hearts belong."

Strengths: Your metaphors attempt to give emotional qualities to physical places. You've created a consistent theme of positive emotions across different settings.

Weakness: Vague descriptions  $\rightarrow$  The phrases "fun and food which power you" and "sweet joy" don't give specific details about what makes these places special. The image of an apartment having "thousands of hearts of happiness" is confusing because apartments aren't typically that large. In "A shopping centre is a mall of fun and food which power you," you don't explain how fun and food give power.

Exemplar: A shopping centre buzzes with laughter as families share meals and friends discover treasures together.

Your narrative shows creativity in using metaphors to describe different concepts and places. You've organised your writing into clear paragraphs that follow a similar pattern, which helps readers follow your thoughts. However, many of your metaphors use general words like "happiness," "joy," and "warmth" without showing what these feelings look like in action.

■ To improve your narrative, try using more specific details that appeal to the senses. For example, instead of saying "A home is a building of sweet joy," you could describe what joy looks like in a home—perhaps the smell of baking, the sound of laughter, or the comfort of a favourite chair. Also, make sure your metaphors match logically. When you say the ocean is calm but has waves, these ideas contradict each other. Additionally, some of your negative descriptions, like "death shooters" for the sun, are unclear and could be replaced with more precise language. Try reading your metaphors aloud to hear if they create clear pictures in the mind.
