Section 1:

#1 (Diary Entry 15.1.24) Strengths: Your opening effectively establishes a relatable emotional situation about losing a close friend. Your use of rhetorical questions creates an authentic diary voice. Weakness: Limited emotional depth. \rightarrow You mention being "quite sad" but don't fully explore or describe these feelings, missing an opportunity to engage readers with your emotional journey. For example, when you write "It is such a bummer," this understates what must be a significant emotional event. Exemplar: *I've been devastated since Emily moved away. My chest feels hollow each morning knowing she won't be there at our usual spot, laughing about nothing and everything.*

#2 (Diary Entry 16.1.25) Strengths: Good use of dialogue integration and showing the positive resolution to your social concerns. Your excitement comes through clearly. Weakness: Telling rather than showing. \rightarrow You simply state that drawing in the library was "so much fun" without providing sensory details or specific moments that made it enjoyable. When you write "We got told of by Mrs Laird for laughing so much," you mention laughter but don't share what caused it. Exemplar: *In the library, Ariane's cartoon of Mr. Peterson with elephant ears had me giggling uncontrollably until Mrs Laird shot us that famous stern look over her glasses.*

#3 (Diary Entry 18.1.25) Strengths: Strong voice in your complaints about school being boring. The specific details about the talent show competition create a vivid picture. Weakness: Underdeveloped narrative structure. \rightarrow The entry jumps quickly from boring school to talent show discussions without transitions. When describing Zeke's performance, you list the elements without creating a vivid scene for readers. The ending feels abrupt without reflection on how you felt about not winning. Exemplar: While I practised my Megan Trainor number in the corner, Zeke commanded the room's attention, his hands a blur as he solved the Rubik's cube while maintaining three juggling balls in the air—the perfect showman preparing to steal the spotlight yet again.

■ Your diary entries show promise with their conversational tone and genuine voice that feels authentic for a young person. However, your writing would benefit from more sensory details to bring scenes to life rather than simply telling readers what happened. Also, consider exploring your emotions more deeply—how did Emily's departure truly

affect you beyond just making you sad? Additionally, you could structure your entries with clearer narrative arcs that build tension and resolution. Try focusing on fewer events but describing them in greater detail to create more engaging entries. When you mention events like playing tag with Ariane or performing in the talent show, bring readers into those moments through specific descriptions of sights, sounds, and feelings.
