#1 - First paragraph Strengths: Your opening paragraph effectively establishes your candidacy and personal qualities. You successfully introduce your character traits of initiative and helpfulness, providing a solid foundation for your speech. Weakness: Limited use of ethos. → Your introduction could more strongly establish your credibility and experience with specific examples rather than general statements. The phrase "I've always been someone who takes initiative" lacks concrete evidence to support this claim. Exemplar: *I've demonstrated my leadership abilities as the coordinator of our successful charity fundraiser last term, where we raised £500 for the local animal shelter, and through my role as team captain in the inter-school quiz competition.*

#2 - Third paragraph ("Moreover, I will always plan fun class events...") Strengths: You effectively appeal to pathos by mentioning enjoyable activities like pizza parties and movies that would excite your classmates. Your commitment to democratic decision-making through class votes shows consideration for others' preferences. Weakness: Underdeveloped logos. → Your reasoning dismisses educational activities too quickly with the example about learning "why $E=mc^2$ ". This limits your appeal to students who might value both fun and intellectual stimulation. The statement "That would be too boring" doesn't acknowledge different learning preferences. Exemplar: *I promise to balance entertaining social events with enriching activities that support our learning goals, ensuring every class member finds something to enjoy while we grow together as a community.*

#3 - Final paragraph Strengths: Your conclusion effectively summarizes your key campaign points, creating a memorable ending with the clever wordplay on "president who is present." Weakness: Repetitive summary. → Your conclusion mainly restates earlier points without adding emotional resonance or a compelling call to action. The phrase "Therefore, vote for Ho Yin" doesn't create urgency or excitement about your candidacy. Exemplar: *Imagine a classroom where your voice matters, where fun and learning go hand in hand, and where your class president is always there for you. That future begins with your vote for Ho Yin today!*

■ Your speech shows enthusiasm and clearly identifies three main campaign promises: helping classmates, being consistently present, and planning enjoyable class events. However, your argument would be more persuasive with specific examples of past leadership experiences to establish your ethos more strongly. Additionally, you could strengthen your logos by explaining exactly how you'll solve problems and report to school leaders - what specific systems will you put in place? Also, consider balancing fun activities with educational ones rather than dismissing learning opportunities entirely. Your repetition of "I will always..." creates emphasis but becomes predictable; varying your phrasing would make your speech more engaging. Finally, incorporating more emotional appeals throughout would help your classmates connect with your vision for the class. Try adding a personal story about how you've helped someone in the past or describe how the classroom atmosphere will feel under your leadership.
