Section 1:

- #1 First paragraph: Strengths: Your opening imagery of "children running around in a pristine environment" creates an appealing vision. You establish your main claim about being qualified for class president clearly. Weakness: Vague promises without specifics → Your opening relies heavily on general statements about making things "happy" and "pristine" without explaining what specific changes you would implement. Phrases like "everything is happy" and "make a great change" lack concrete details that would convince voters of your actual plans. Exemplar: "If elected class president, I will implement weekly playground clean-up teams and teacher-student collaboration sessions to create both a cleaner environment and stronger community connections between students and staff."
- #2 Paragraph on confidence: Strengths: Good use of well-known examples (Musk, Jobs, Gates) to support your point. You include a personal anecdote about the spelling bee to demonstrate your confidence. Weakness: Underdeveloped comparison → Your comparison to famous entrepreneurs feels disconnected from a class president role. The spelling bee example could be strengthened by explaining what you learned from the experience or how this confidence would specifically benefit your classmates as their president. Exemplar: "My confidence, demonstrated when I participated in the spelling bee competition in front of 50 classmates, will help me advocate boldly for your needs when meeting with teachers and school administrators about improving our lunch options."
- #3 Final paragraph: Strengths: Effective summary of your key qualities. Good attempt at providing a call to action. Weakness: Repetitive conclusion → Your concluding paragraph merely restates that you have persistence, confidence and passion without tying these qualities to specific benefits for voters. The claim that you will "upgrade" your classmates' future lacks substantive examples of how this will happen. Exemplar: "With my persistent dedication to completing projects, confidence to speak up for our class needs, and passion for creating a better school environment, I ask for your vote so together we can establish a recycling programme, organise more inclusive school events, and create a student feedback system."

■ Your speech contains enthusiastic energy and presents some good qualities for a class president candidate. However, your piece would be much more persuasive if you provided specific examples of what changes you would make rather than abstract promises. Try focusing each paragraph on one concrete initiative you would implement as class president. Additionally, consider addressing actual school issues your classmates care about rather than general statements about improvement. You could strengthen your ethos by mentioning specific school activities where you've demonstrated leadership, and enhance your logos by explaining the step-by-step process of how you would implement changes. Your pathos appeals could be more effective if you connected emotionally with voters by acknowledging their current frustrations or hopes. Remember that voters are more likely to support candidates with clear, actionable plans rather than just positive qualities.
