Weakness: Run-on sentences and unclear structure  $\rightarrow$  This paragraph contains several sentences that run together without proper punctuation or clear connections. For example, "No one would ever be racists to you nope you heard me correctly" combines multiple thoughts without proper structure. The paragraph would be stronger if you organised your thoughts into distinct, well-structured sentences. People in Beijing are welcoming to everyone, regardless of appearance or background. No one experiences racism here, as I've made this a top priority in our community.

Strengths: You've included a specific statistic which adds credibility to your argument. You've also emphasised safety as an important feature of your ideal Beijing.

Weakness: Contradictory information  $\rightarrow$  You mention Beijing is the "31st safest place" but then state there were "4.42 million criminal cases." This seems to contradict your claim about exceptional safety. Also, the phrase "safety that you could never possibly think of" doesn't clearly explain what makes the safety special. Beijing ranks among the world's 31 safest cities. Our crime rates have dropped significantly, making our city safer than it has been in ten years. Visitors often comment on how secure they feel while exploring our streets.

#3 "Finally, justice for our community, leading international human rights groups continue to point to widespread abuse in the country's judicial system. Beijing lets you roam freely they

will most certainly not give you minimized freedom and will not say you can't do this you can't do that."

Strengths: You've attempted to address the important topic of justice and freedom, which shows you're thinking about fundamental rights in your ideal city.

Weakness: Unclear messaging → The first sentence mentions "widespread abuse" which contradicts your positive vision. The double negatives in "will not give you minimised freedom and will not say you can't do this" make your point difficult to understand. In my Beijing, justice means everyone receives fair treatment. Our legal system protects individual freedoms, allowing citizens to make their own choices without unnecessary restrictions, while still maintaining order and safety.

■ Your piece shows great enthusiasm for creating an ideal Beijing where people would want to live. You've focused on three important values: equality, safety, and justice. However, your writing could benefit from clearer organisation of ideas within each paragraph. Try starting each paragraph with a clear topic sentence that states your main point. Also, make sure all your examples and details support your main idea rather than contradicting it. For instance, when discussing safety, focus on positive statistics that show how safe Beijing is. When writing about freedom and justice, explain specifically what freedoms people have rather than using double negatives. Additionally, you could strengthen your conclusion by summarising your main points more clearly and ending with a strong final thought that leaves readers feeling inspired about your vision for Beijing.
